Bowers & Wilkins Sound Sessions Presents An Exclusive, Intimate Performance by Amos Lee at Le Poisson Rouge in NYC on June 18, 2013

North Reading, MA — June 4, 2013 — Bowers & Wilkins has confirmed that Amos Lee will be the next artist featured as part of their exclusive Sound Sessions music series.

The invite-only Bowers & Wilkins Sound Sessions are designed to engage with audiences directly by offering fans access to VIP-only, listening events with their favorite artists while experiencing the music through Bowers & Wilkins' portfolio of best-in-class speakers, including the 802 Diamond, Zeppelin Air, and mobile HiFi headphones. For his fifth album, *Mountains of Sorrow, Rivers of Song*, Amos Lee took a different path for the recording, working in a new city with a new producer. Recording with Amos' road tested touring band, the album was the first project to be recorded in a brand-new studio, built in a converted church in Nashville by producer Jay Joyce (Emmylou Harris, Little Big Town, Eric Church). The follow-up to 2011's chart-topping *Mission Bell* brings the artist into new sonic territory, while retaining the trenchant impact of the scenes,

characters, and stories in his writing. Joyce introduced a broader palette to Amos' work, creating a richness and a variety that's never distracting or self-conscious. Being in Nashville also allowed several remarkable guests to come by the sessions. Alison Krauss and Patty Griffin lend heavenly vocals while instrumentalists Jerry Douglas, Mickey Raphael and Jeff Coffin of the Dave Matthews Band add depth and color.
